Volunteering Applying and Procedures:

1)

- Visit our website and explore the placement introductions. Choose appropriate internship/voluntary work placement for yourself and send us an email. If you can't find suitable placement, please write the description to the email.
 - Volunteers should contact us for the first time latest about 1 month before coming to Tanzania.
 - People coming to do internship should contact us for the first time latest 2 months before coming to Tanzania.
 - Send us your CV and Letter of Motivation, both in English. Tell in short about yourself, about your studies/education, about your previous work experience on that field and also if you have done some previous internships at the field. In the Letter of Motivation, you should also mention the dates and the length of the internship/volunteering period.
 - Remember that the documents are for your placement, not for CVS-Tanzania office.

2)

- If you have chosen a placement from our list, we will confirm from the placement that there is possibility for you to work.
 - If you have not sent a description of new placement we will find that for you.
 - If you are coming to do your internship, you need to send us contact information for the teacher who takes care of international internships in your school. We will contact him/her about the contract.

3)

- We will prepare a contract with the placement of your choice and send it to you to sign (and your school).
 - At this point you need to book your flights to Kilimanjaro/Dar International Airport and send us your flight details.
 - ***When you book your flight remember that you can stay only exactly 3 months in Tanzania with your visa. (e.g if you enter the country on 3rd of May you need to exit latest on 3rd of August)***

4)

- We will send you the invoice and instructions for a proper working permit.
- You will enter the country and purchase a student **visa** on arrival or online before your trip. The price for student visa is 50 USD.

5)

- Make sure that your passport is valid for 6 months after your trip to Tanzania.
- **Get all the vaccinations needed:**
 - A and B hepatitis
 - Yellow fever (you need to show the vaccination certification at the airport)
 - MMR vaccination
 - Tetanus
 - Cholera (optional)
 - Get malaria prophylaxis
 - Get adequate insurance for yourself and your luggage
 - Typhoid fever (optional).
- **Accommodation:** The intern/volunteer is hosted in local host family and/or in hostel during his/her practicum, where he/she will be sharing meals and other basic need services.
- **On weekends or on your free time:** enjoy the beautiful Tanzania nature by participating in different trips arranged by CVS-Tanzania. Visiting waterfalls, Cultural Programs, Coffee tour, Swimming on a hot spring, going to Maasai Village, wildlife Safaris, Mt. Kilimanjaro Climbing, Safaris, beach holidays (Pangani and Zanzibar) etc. Give us chance to make your visit unforgettable. <https://www.tanzaniaparks.go.tz>
